GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Springhill Hospice (Lottery) Limited is a wholly owned subsidiary of Springhill Hospice and all profits generated by the Lottery are paid to the Hospice.

The Lottery is registered with the Gambling Commission, under the Gambling Act 2005, and is defined as a "Society Lottery".

The Draw takes place every Friday.

To participate in the Lottery you must be aged 16 (sixteen) years or over.

Participants joining the Lottery are issued with their own, randomly selected, unique 5 digit number.

The allocation of numbers, and the weekly Draw, are undertaken by an independent Computer Bureau

The cost is £1 per week. In the event of non-payment a member's number is withheld from the draw. Payment cannot be retrospective.

All members are responsible for providing the Lottery with accurate and up to date contact details

All Prizes are paid by cheque no later than the week following the Friday on which the draw has been held.

Lottery membership can be cancelled at any time by notifying the Lottery Office in writing, by telephone, by e-mail or in person.

Full details of the Terms and Conditions, together with copies of the Complaints Procedure, can be obtained from the Lottery Office.

HOW OUR LOTTERY WORKS



Each entry is for £1.00 per week and entitles you to a unique Game Number. Every Friday, when our draw takes place, 53 numbers are selected at random from our Paying Members for that week.

£1000—1st PRIZE

£200—2nd PRIZE

£100—3rd PRIZE

plus 50 x £10 winners

All prizes are paid by cheque and sent direct to the winners.

Q. How can I pay into the Lottery Game?

A. Either by sending a cheque to the Lottery Office, by making a payment by Standing Order from your Bank Account or by cash if we have a collector in your area.

Q. Can I have more than one number in the Lottery Game?

A. Certainly. You make a separate payment for each number or, if paying by Standing Order, complete a separate mandate for each number required.

Q. How do I join the Lottery Game?

A. SIMPLE! Just complete the form on the next page with your name, address and bank details or enclose a cheque (minimum £13.00) made payable to Springhill Hospice (Lottery) Ltd
