Islamic Arts project with Kyp

Supporting all members of our community has always been our top priority, so we were delighted to have been awarded an £8,000 grant from Dying Matters, which allowed us to better engage with the Muslim and Asian communities in Rochdale through an Islamic Art Project.

The project enabled us to work in a culturally appropriate manner, in partnership with two experienced community organisations: Kashmir Youth Project (KYP) and Rochdale Women's Welfare Association, allowing us to engage with members of the Muslim and Asian community. We utilised the medium of Arabic calligraphy workshops, led by Razwan UI Haq (QEST Scholar) to bridge cultural and linguistic barriers, in order to open up conversations about death, dying and grief which are often difficult subjects to tackle.

We delivered a total of eight workshops to two separate groups at KYP, which empowered participants to take comfort from their religion, while producing art around the theme of death, build trust and increase understanding between them and Hospice staff. Our team had the opportunity to learn about the cultural and religious needs and practices of the group members in relation to death, as well as

sharing information about the work of the Hospice; so that all members of the community can make fully informed choices around support requirements for themselves, loved ones and community members, when faced with a diagnosis of a life limiting illness.

Participants created their own artwork based on Turkish marbling techniques and incorporated some of the 99 names of Allah in Arabic calligraphy. At the end, they were able to choose their favourite piece to frame and take home for their families to enjoy. The artwork was then displayed at an Eid celebration event hosted by KYP, and all participants were invited to join in the celebration.

Our next workshop will be delivered in partnership with Rochdale Women's Welfare Association throughout July, and we look forward to sharing updates from this soon!

Launched earlier this year, our 'Makin Memories Tree' is a beautiful way to honour someone you love.

Set in the heart of the Springhill gardens, the 'Makin Memories Tree' helps us remember loved ones who have sadly died. The 'Makin Memories Tree' offers a meaningful way to remember someone you love, whilst helping Springhill Hospice to provide crucial Hospice care and make every moment count across Rochdale, Heywood and Middleton.

You can choose to dedicate your leaf in memory of your loved one, to mark a special occasion, or to recognise the contribution that you, or someone else, has made to the Hospice. Each leaf represents someone special, each with their own unique meaning.

You will be asked to make a donation to the Hospice which will include the cost of producing an engraved leaf with your personal dedication, that will be placed on the 'Makin Memories Tree' for a year. After this time, you will be given the option to renew your leaf for further years or collect your leaf to treasure.

Celebrating 35 years

of Springhill Hospice

This was the start of the Springhill journey, with the Fundraising Appeal being launched by founder Margaret Geoghegan MBE.

1983

Margaret Geoghegan received her MBE for Services to the Community. Later that year the Hospice building was completed.

1988



After the Hospice had been open for almost a year, patients began attending Day Hospice.

1991

After a fundraising campaign, the Day Hospice was officially opened. (It is now known as Day Therapies.)

1994

1999 saw the 10th anniversary of the Hospice. The Tree of Life was unveiled in the Hospice to celebrate those contributors who had gone above and beyond.

1999

The Education Suite was funded and built by 2001 thanks to a National Lottery grant.

2001

1987

400 people from across Rochdale cut the first sod on the site that was soon to become the Hospice.

The Hospice celebrated its 30th anniversary.

On 8th October 1989 Springhill Hospice opened and begun caring for patients. In November the Hospice was officially opened by HRH Princess Anne.

Our Bereavement Service was commissioned by the CCG, to provide support to people across the Borough.

The first Woman of Rochdale event took place. 1993 also saw work on the Day <u>Hospice bui</u>lding begin.

Springhill gained Investors in People status and were the first Hospice in the country to do so. 2005

Due to the Covid 19 pandemic, the Hospice had to change all its many processes in order to care for patients in the safest way, whilst operating under the new government guidelines, which meant adhereing to strict social distance guidelines, and the temporary closure of Day Therapies.

Springhill was successfully awarded a E44k grant from HSBC to refresh the patient and communal areas of the Hospice, improving our patients' experience with us, and creating a more homely and welcoming atmosphere for everyone to enjoy.

Founder of the Hospice and Chairman of the Board of Trustees, Margaret Geoghehan MBE, retired and was appointed President of the Hospice. The Hospice undertook a major £430k refurbishment project funded with a grant from the Department of Health.


